## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Indigenous person, and can provide verification of Indigenous affiliation or status
- Enrolled in a full-time post-secondary or trades program and maintain satisfactory academic standing throughout the program
- Plan of achieving education and career goals
- Gommitted to updating Strike on academic progress throughout duration of their program
- Must live in Western Canada

#### **SELECTION PROCESS**

- **4** A panel of Strike Group employees will select the recipient of the scholarship.
- The panel will consider applicants:
  - Program of study (all disciplines will be considered; however priority will be given to students in programs that support our industry);
  - Academic and career goals;
  - Community and volunteer participation;
  - Contents of application; and
  - Reference letters.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants must provide:
  - Proof of enrollment in either post-secondary or trades program;
  - Verification of Indigenous affiliation or status;
  - Two reference letters;
  - Completed Strike Group Indigenous Scholarship application; and
  - Submit all documents together in **one** email to scholarships@strikegroup.ca prior to the deadline.
