Guidelines

Strike will ensure that records are kept and maintained for all injuries, incidents and safety related activities. Activities will be documented on the Safety Statistic Form. Members of the Strike Executive will review safety statistics monthly.

Statistics will be used as a measuring tool to monitor safety performance.

The company will utilize ANSI standards as indicators of safety performance. The company will calculate TRI (Total Recordable Injuries) and LTI (Lost Time Injuries) frequency rates on a monthly and annual basis.

(TRI) -Total Recordable Incident Frequency Rate

- Includes (MW) Modified Work, (MA) Medical Aid, (as defined by CAPP standards) and (LT) Lost time (lost workday other than the day of the injury)

$$\frac{MW + MA + LT \times 200,000}{\text{Employee Exposure Hours}}$$

(LTI) – Lost Time Incident Frequency Rate

- Work related injury or disease, which disables the worker beyond the day of the injury.

$$\frac{LT \times 200,000}{\text{Employee Exposure Hours}}$$
