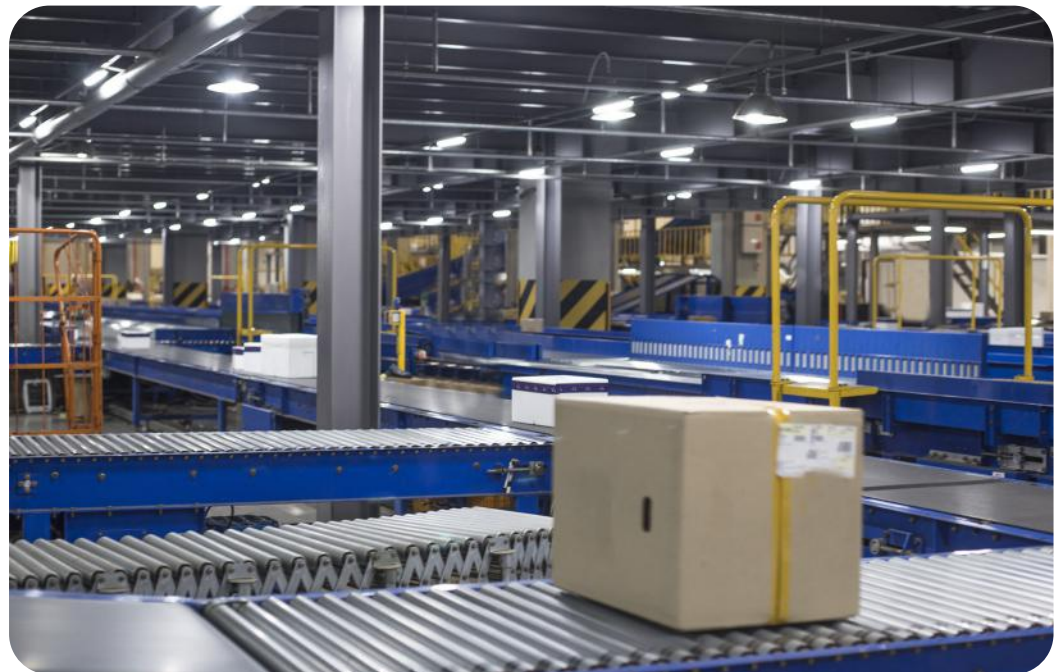

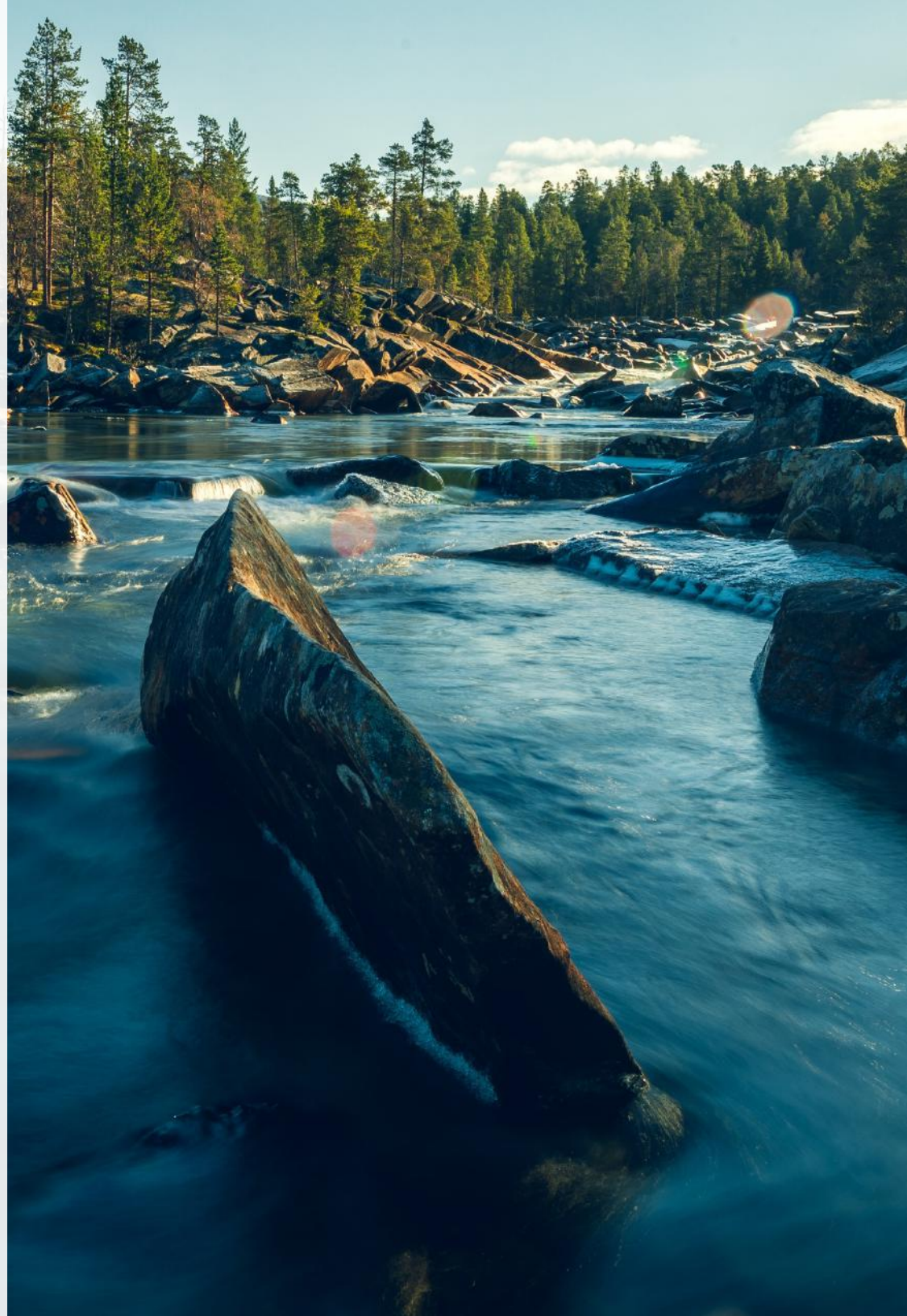

We regularly sponsor and participate in events with the communities where we have built relationships.

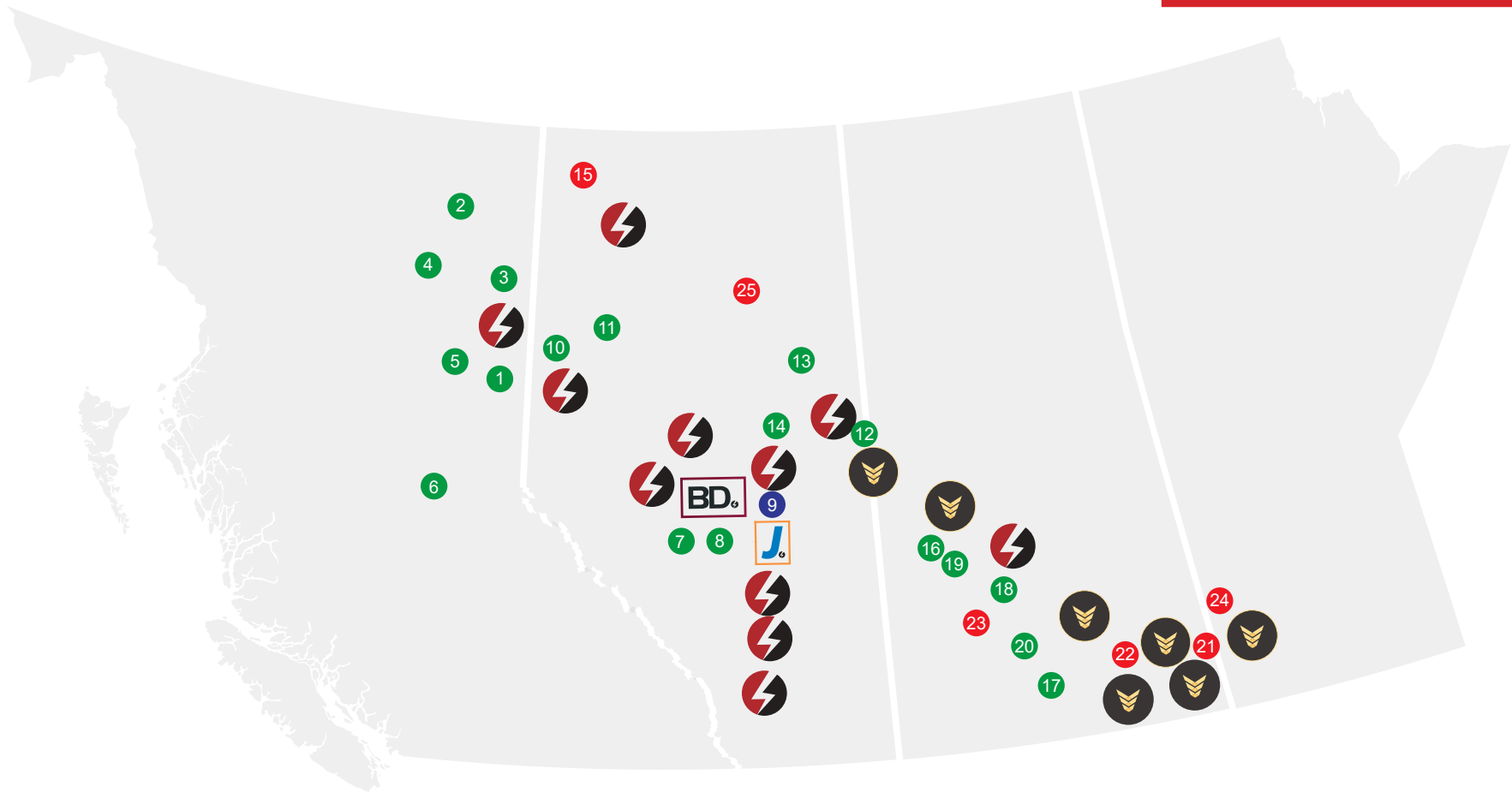

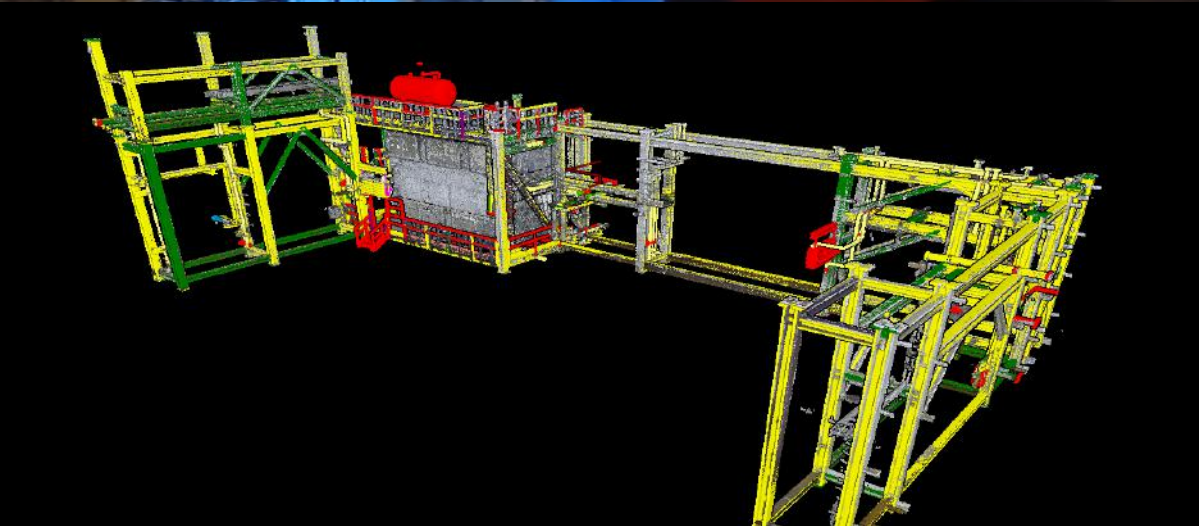
