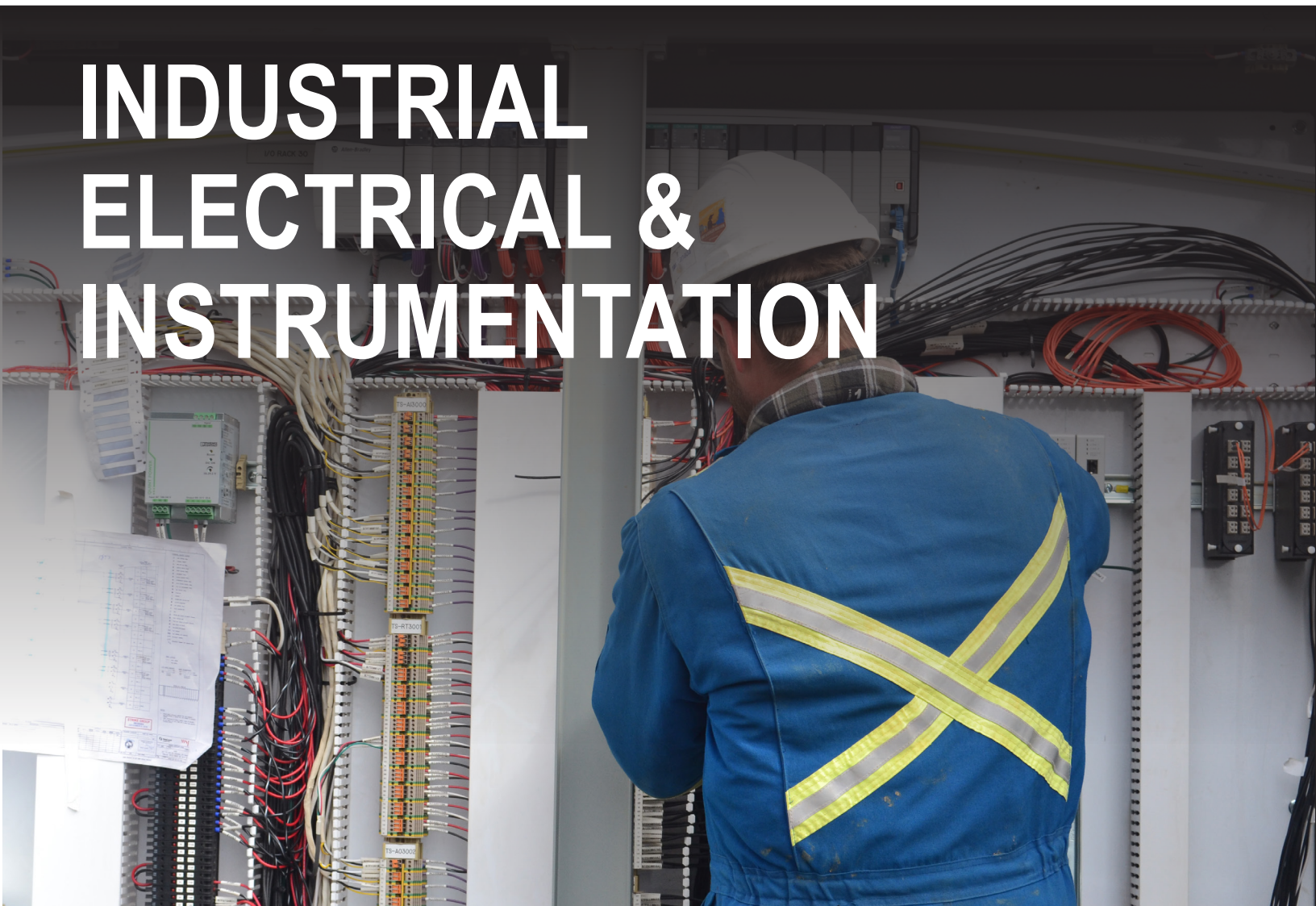

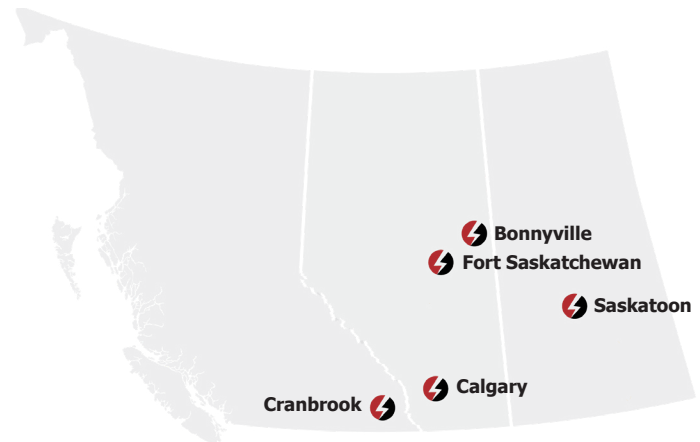

OIL & GAS



Foster Creek Amine Claus

The Amine Clause facility was a modular design built to enhance sulfur management and meet environmental regulations following the completion of the previous FC3 Optimization debottlenecking project. We completed both the electrical and instrumentation scopes of work.



Souris TX Replacement

The Souris LP Canada Power Transformer Replacement project was to provide a second substation transformer that will supply part of the electrical load at Souris. The new 230kV substation and transformer were installed to provide sufficient backup for maintenance outages or a failure event of the existing substation transformer. The project includes electrical, mechanical, civil, and structural components.



Hidden Lake North B2 Unit Addition

Strike successfully executed the electrical and instrumentation scope for TC Energy's Hidden Lake North Unit B2 Addition, supporting the installation of a new 30 MW compressor unit and associated facility infrastructure on the NGTL system in northwestern Alberta. The project included the supply and installation of electrical distribution, grounding, cable tray, conduit, power and control cabling, lighting, heat trace, instrumentation, communications, equipment terminations, testing, and commissioning support.



Fiber on the Pipe (FoP)

The general project scope of work was to install the infrastructure required to support the fibre optic installation at the various Trans Mountain pump stations, terminals, and remote main line block valve sites. At each location either a HUB site will be installed or a telecom connection. Hubs sites have buildings and infrastructure and telecom sites are a fibre cable connection to existing infrastructure. The project took place at 42 locations throughout Alberta and British Columbia

MINING



Potash Well Pad 16 Site Construction, Module Supply and Install

Strike successfully executed the off site and on site electrical and instrumentation scopes for K+S Wellpad 16 Project. The scope included the supply and installation of the electrical distribution, fire and security systems, cable tray, grounding system, heat trace, glanding and terminating, instrumentation, cathodic protection, testing and commissioning support. This project saw the management of up to 30 direct field workers, not including multiple sub contractors.



Vanscoy Potash Mine (VPO)

The project included the procurement and installation of instrument tubing and supports for the hydraulic system in a new mill located 3km SW in Saskatchewan. Installation of approximately 2,000m of 1-1/4" tubing for hydraulic system over nine (9) floors, installation of supports and racks for tubing, and the installation of valves and fittings.

PETROCHEMICAL



FS1-X Project

The purpose of the FS1-X project is to increase the capacity of the ethylene plant by about 130,000 tonnes/year with the addition of another furnace.

This project included the supply and installation of the electrical (low and medium voltages) and instrumentation services for the FS-1 expansion. The project included the installation of new 700hp and 400hp compressors. Once complete this installation will assist with debottlenecking the existing plant as well as the integration of the new furnace.

All 5kV cable installation was completed by Strike and final terminations and testing completed by Strike's 3rd party contractor.



ABB Upgrade

Dow Poly Train T2 Mod Migration was a control system modernization project that replaced the existing Modcan I/O infrastructure with ABB IOENS technology. The project included extensive electrical, communications, and control room upgrades across multiple operating areas, including new UPS systems, fiber optic and network infrastructure, server room enhancements, and control console installations, enabling a reliable transition to the facility's next-generation control platform.

Harmony Lake B Pump Station E&I

New electrical and instrumentation installation for a privately owned pump station to fill, aerate and circulate water in Harmony Lake.

Project Scope

- Installation of transformer base and grounding to Fortis Alberta's specifications
- Supply and installation of CDP, VFDs x2 for (2) 250HP pumps
- Supply and installation of building power and lighting
- Supply and install PLC control cabinet for control of pumps, levels and HVAC system
- Supply and installation of level and temp instrumentation, calibration and commissioning



NCWS WP09 Mountain View Pump Station

Electrical and instrumentation installation for City of Calgary Mountain View Pump Station Upgrades.

Project Scope

- Demolition of existing electrical distribution and controls
- Installation of extensive concrete encased duct bank, tie-in to existing system
- Supply and installation of cable and cable tray, new distribution equipment, building power / lighting, PLC control cabinets and local control panels, all new instrumentation, calibration and commissioning

This project included the supply and installation of electrical (low and medium voltage) and controls for two (2) low voltage MCC buildings and two (2) medium voltage MCC buildings for the ARC Dawson Ph3 Gas Plant.

S1701 Temporary Power UPI

The DOW Temporary Power project was part of the UPI program, which laid the groundwork for utility distribution of 15kV, 35kV, and 600V temporary power infrastructure across the entire Fort Saskatchewan plant to support the Dow Path2Zero expansion project, which aims to create the world's first net-zero emissions integrated ethylene cracker and derivatives site.



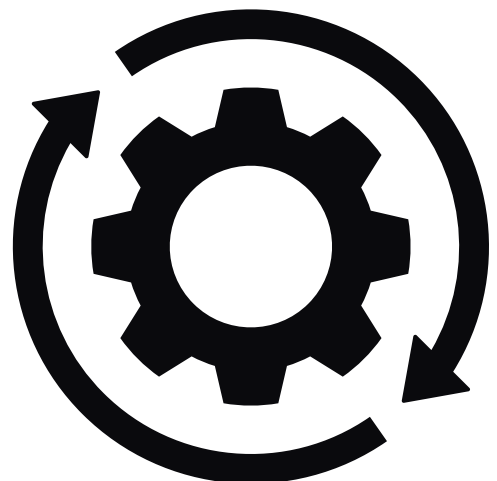
Fort Saskatchewan Temporary Power Path2Zero

The Linde Temporary Power project provided the temporary electrical infrastructure required to support construction of Linde's new world-scale integrated clean hydrogen and atmospheric gases facilities in Fort Saskatchewan, Alberta. This landmark project will supply clean hydrogen, nitrogen, and utility services to support Dow's Path2Zero initiative.
